The Work We Do

The Nov. 16th issue of the Chronicle of Higher Education reports that a community college degree often smooths the path to a B.A. We hear of worries about a low college completion rate at both 2 year and 4 year colleges, but a report from the National Student Clearinghouse Research Center found that almost three-quarters of students who completed an associate degree and then transferred to a 4 year school earned a B.A. within 4 years of transferring.

The director of the Center for the Study of Community Colleges in Los Angeles stated that this clearly shows that students reach "greater baccalaureate attainment having" first earned an associate degree. It should be gratifying that our work counts.
